As a Kitchen Assistant your role will be to support the Catering Supervisor in delivering an effective catering service operating to the highest standards of food safety.

#### The successful candidate will be responsible for the following duties:

- Assist with the provision of food including preparation, cooking, and serving meals, portion control, special diets, allergens, and intolerances (where advised).
- Preparation of the dining areas and service counter.
- Cleaning of dining, kitchen, and staff facilities.
- Operate tills (where appropriate), adhere to existing IT working practices and procedures and undertake relevant training and development activities.
- Follow safe systems of work, maintain appropriate levels of hygiene and safeguarding in accordance with School policies, The Code of Practice and Food Safety Legislation to maintain a safe environment.
- Actively market the service to promote and maintain good relationships with all customers. This may require catering outside the current contracted hours, to include new intake events, parents evening and hospitality catering.
